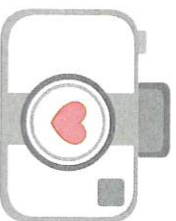


We hope you have fun if you choose to complete any of these activities!

There are so many Christmas shows and films on TV. Keep a list of things you watch.



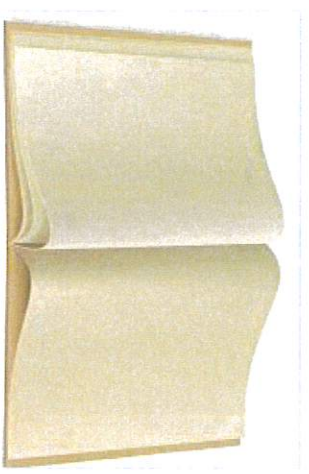
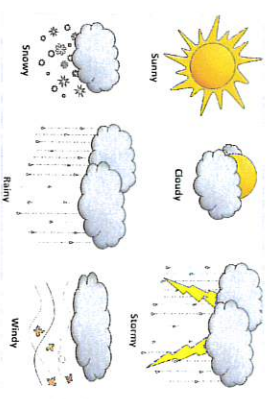
Can you write a film review?
