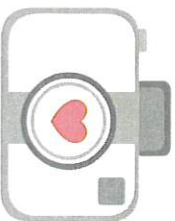

If you complete 8+ activities you will get a gold certificate

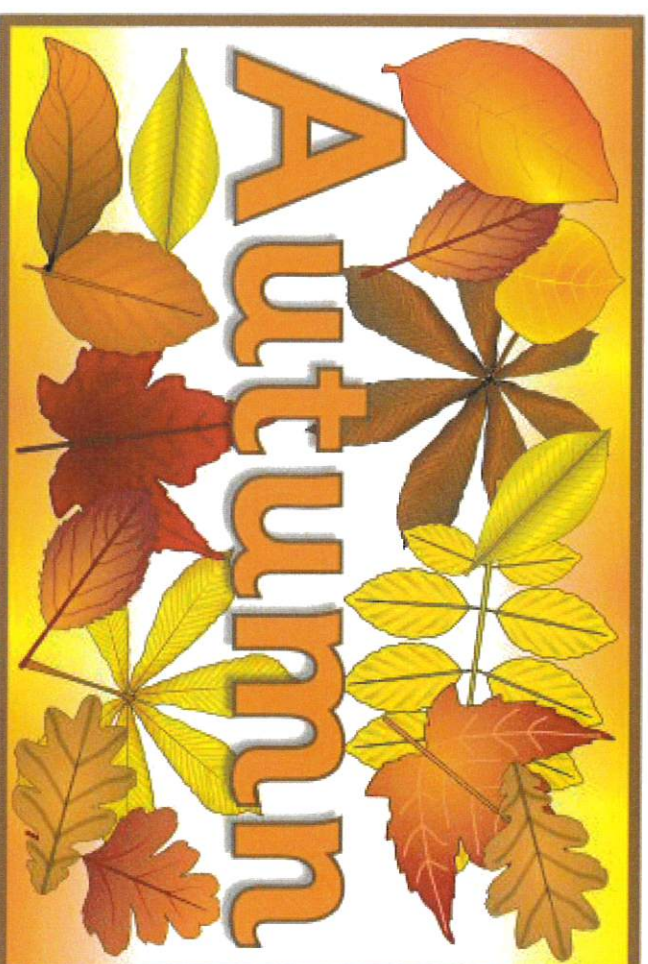

Have you heard any fireworks or been to a bonfire? Write a poem about bonfire night!

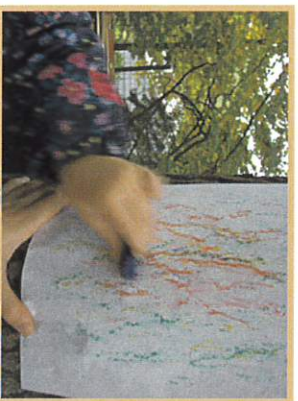


Go on a search for some conkers—you can make this conker worm? (you must have help for this activity!)
